

The Clean Air Zone starts 26th September 2022. Passenger cars will not be charged. Check if you need to pay.







Public attitudes towards air quality and the Bradford


Clean Air Zone: (April – December 2021; N=1,949) Mebrahtu, McEachan et al, Submitted

Poor Pakistani communities




